


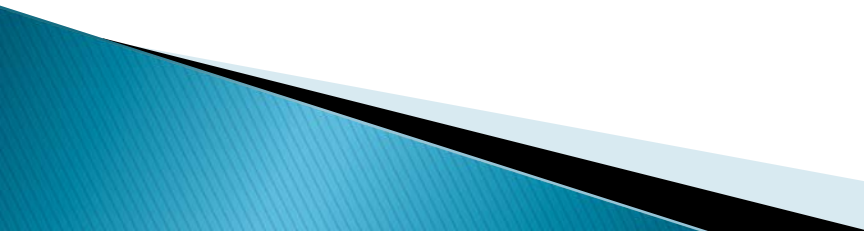
# Servants of God and Son's of the Devil

Romans 16:1-24

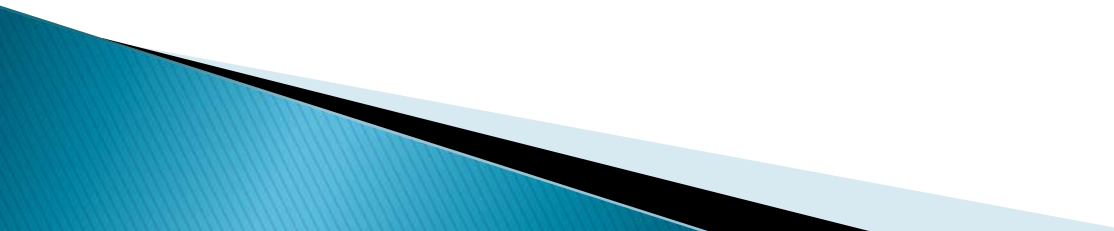
# I. Not every servant has an office.

- ▶ Rom 16:1–2
  - ▶ John 2:5–9, Rom 13:4, Rom 15:8 – examples of the use of diakonos
  - ▶ I Tim 3:8–13 qualifications for deacons
  - ▶ Acts 6:1–4 first appointment of deacons
  - ▶ I Tim 2:8–12, Titus 2:3–5 clear examples of God’s calling
  - ▶ Acts 21:17–19 example of elders

## II. The servants of God are easy to identify.

- ▶ Rom 16:3–16, and 21–24
  - ▶ I Tim 1:15 they are humble
  - ▶ Rom 12:1 they are self sacrificing
  - ▶ II Cor 11:22–33 suffer well
  - ▶ II Tim 4:1–4 they teach the Truth
  - ▶ Rom 13:1 they submit to authority

# III. The Son's of Satan will be harder to know.

- ▶ Rom 16:17–18
  - ▶ II Cor 11:13–15 wear Satan's Disguise
  - ▶ James 4:1–6 Cause division
  - ▶ Acts 20:28–30 Teach incorrect doctrine
  - ▶ Titus 3:9–11 dealing with divisive man

  - ▶ Gen 3:15 Satan's future
  - ▶ John 16:33
  - ▶ I John 4:3–5
-
